<p>shoplifters who became aggressive toward them.</p>			
<p>Once on scene I identified the suspects as Joshua Bishop and Westly Attaway. Both had been placed into handcuffs by the complainant, Lane Rogers, and had blood on their faces and shirts. When I inquired about their injuries both suspects advised they had been assaulted by the complainant and his employee. As I continued my conversation with the suspects I noticed a contusion which was bleeding on the top left portion of Attaway's head and it appeared a few of suspect Bishop's teeth had been knocked out. I immediately advised dispatch to send medical personnel to our location. While waiting for paramedics both suspect continued to state the store employees had assaulted them with a cane, but later changed the weapon to a pipe. When paramedics arrived I overheard suspect Attaway tell them he had been struck in the top of the head with a hammer.</p>			
<p>I then made contact with the complainant who advised his firearm had been secured and returned to the store by his employee. He continued by advising he had captured both suspects on video concealing multiple bottles of liquor on their person while inside Chubby Cheeks liquor store. He stated the suspects left the store so quickly he was unable to leave his office in time to stop them. He further stated he, his father, Allen Rogers, and a store employee retrieved his vehicle and began searching the area for the suspects until they located them in the 4500 block of Garland Avenue. He told me suspect Attaway became extremely belligerent toward him when he confronted him about the stolen liquor. He stated suspect Attaway ran toward him in an aggressive manner which made him retrieve his pistol from the belt line of his pants. He further stated he aimed the pistol at suspect Attaway in an attempt to deter him from proceeding toward him but his action had no effect, so he oriented his pistol toward the ditch on the east side of the roadway and fired a single shot into the ground. He told me this caused suspect Attaway to divert his attention away from him and to his father. He stated Attaway grabbed his father and began pulling on him so he kicked him, Attaway, in the chest causing him to fall into the ditch. He further stated he ordered Attaway to stay on ground but Attaway refused and began coming toward him again. He told me he retrieved his handcuffs from his vehicle but had to kick Attaway in the chest again so that he would stay on the ground so that he could secure his hands behind his back. He stated he did not know when or how Attaway received the injuries to his head and did not see what had taken place between his employee and suspect Bishop.</p>			
<p>Officer Colley then accompanied the complainant to the store to review the video tape while officer Cockrell and I assisted paramedics with the suspects. See Officer Cockrell's and Officer Colley's supplemental reports for further information.</p>			
<p>Paramedics informed me the injuries the suspects had sustained where more severe than initially perceived. Upon learning this I observed suspect Attaway slump over into the lap of suspect Bishop and become unresponsive for several seconds. Attaway then became responsive again and began asking where he was. Suspect Bishop then slumped onto his right side and became unresponsive.</p>			
<p>While paramedics transported the suspects from the scene Sergeant Hunter and I began canvassing the area. We noticed a pool of blood on the east side of the roadway with several droplets of blood nearby. Sergeant Hunter made the decision to notify Detectives of the incident and I began placing cones around the area where I located the blood droplets. As I continued to canvass I located several more droplets of blood along the east side of the roadway north of our location. I placed additional cones and expanded the scene.</p>			
<p>Detective Gatlin arrived on scene and I briefed him on the information I had gathered up to this point. The scene was then turned over to Detective Gatlin. He advised to treat the incident as a Robbery and contacted Crime Scene Technician Yonts to respond to process the scene.</p>			
<p>I seized the complainant's two pairs of Peerless brand handcuffs as evidence after they had been removed from suspects Attaway and Bishop. They were recorded on a property record and I placed them into property locker 19 at the police department.</p>
