and become unresponsive for several seconds. Attaway then became responsive again and began asking

where he was. Suspect Bishop then slumped onto his right side and became unresponsive. While paramedics transported the suspects from the scene Sergeant Hunter and I began canvassing the area. We noticed a pool of blood on the east side of the roadway with several droplets of blood nearby. Sergeant Hunter made the decision to notify Detectives of the incident and I began placing cones around the area where I located the blood droplets. As I continued to canvass I located several more droplets of blood along the east side of the roadway north of our location. I placed additional cones and expanded the scene.

Detective Gatlin arrived on scene and I briefed him on the information I had gathered up to this point. The scene was then turned over to Detective Gatlin. He advised to treat the incident as a Robbery and contacted Crime Scene Technician Yonts to respond to process the scene.

I seized the complainant's two pairs of Peerless brand handcuffs as evidence after they had been removed from suspects Attaway and Bishop. They were recorded on a property record and I placed them

into property locker 19 at the police department.
