WHEREAS, the Arkansas Board of Pardons and Paroles has recommended leniency for John C. Lohbauer from the sentence imposed upon him for his conviction of the crime of capital murder in the case of Texarkana, Arkansas Police Officer Ed Worrell; and,

Lohbauer and hereby authorizes and directs the City Manager to state said opposition by a letter to the Honorable Bill Clinton, Governor of the State of Arkansas, together with a copy of this resolution.
